



## **INSTALLATION**

1.



Remove the torch from the holder.

Place the holder in desired position and align the product, marking the surface through the holes.


2. Check the wall to ensure there is no wiring, pipes etc.



### (If fitting to brick wall)


Drill 6mm diameter holes aproximately 35mm deep. Insert the wall plugs.

Insert screws through the holder and into the surface.


Reattach the torch to the holder.




Check battery polarity when installing.

Reverse procedure to re-install battery pack.


# Operating

Remove Torch from holder, which automatically activates the LED light.

To turn off, place the Torch back into the holder, ensuring the pin of the holder correctly aligns with the Torch unit.
